- A Guide to Japanese Taxes: 1981-82. Yuji Gomi; Tokyo, Japan: 1981. Pp. 282. Paper. A practical guide to the main features of the Japanese tax system based upon laws, regulations and circulars in effect, generally on April 1, 1981.
- A Guide to the Law and Legal Literature of Bolivia. Clagett, H.L.; New York, N.Y.: Gordon Press, 1981. Pp. viii, 110. Cloth. A reprint of a 1947 edition and one of a series of guides which briefly highlight the law and literature of Latin countries.
- Antitrust and American Business Abroad. Atwood, J.R. and Brewster, K.; Colorado Springs, Colo.: Shepard's/McGraw-Hill, 2d ed. 1981. 2 Vol. Part of the International Practice Series offering a comprehensive and up to date treatment of the subject.
- Aviation Insurance. Margo, R.D.; London, England: Butterworth & Co. Ltd., 1980. Pp. 363. Cloth. An examination of a wide variety of forms and applications of insurance law, based primarily on principles of English aviation insurance law, but also including an examination of other jurisdictions.
- Canadian Tort Law: Cases, Notes and Materials. Linden, A.M. and Wright, C.A.; Toronto, Canada: Butterworth & Co. Ltd., 7th ed. 1980. Pp. 1024. Paper. A casebook offering thorough coverage of Canadian tort law, helpful to both the student and the practitioner.
- Central America and the Caribbean. Brown, G. and Hovey, G., eds.; New York, N.Y.: The New York Times—Arno Press, 1980. Pp. ix, 412. A compilation of excerpts from select newspaper articles which relate to Central America and the Caribbean, arranged chronologically from Nov. 3, 1868 through Feb. 15, 1978.
- Comparative Government and Politics. Hitchner, D.G. and Levine, C.; New York, N.Y.: Harper & Row, Publishers, 2d ed. 1981. Pp. viii, 344. Cloth. An analysis of 170 states presently in existence, which offers a short but complete introduction to comparative government and politics.
- Decisions of International Institutions before Domestic Courts. Schreuer, C.C.; New York, N.Y.: Oceana Publications, 1980. Pp. xiii, 407. Cloth. This edition updates and translates an earlier edition printed in German, and discusses various aspects of the use of municipal decisions in international law.

- Doing Business in Japan. Zentaro Kitagawa; New York, N.Y.: Matthew Bender, 1980. 5 Vol. Loose leaf. A survey of all Japanese law, serving as a preliminary guide for the English speaking practitioner.
- The Hamburg Rules on Carriage of Goods by Sea. Monkabady, S., ed.; Boston, Mass.: A.W. Sijthoff—Leyden, 1978. Pp. xxi, 358. Cloth. A compilation of addresses, essays and lectures used by the Draft Convention on the Carriage of Goods by Sea, drawn up by the United Nations Committee on International Trade Law.
- Improving Compliance with International Law. Fisher, R.; Charlottesville, N.C.: University of Virginia Press, 1981. Pp. 370. Cloth. The fourteenth volume in the Procedural Aspects of International Law Series. The author explores techniques for the reduction of international conflict through increased state compliance, alternatives to tradition, notions and techniques for enforcing international law.
- The Intellectual Property Law of Japan. Teruo Doi; The Netherlands: Sijthoff & Noordhoff, 1980. Pp. xx, 335. A comprehensive treatise written for foreign inventors and authors and their attorneys seeking to protect their intellectual property in Japan. Statutes and cases relating to Japanese trademark, patent, and copyright law are fully discussed.
- International Trade Practice. Hertzberg, M.A., Kaye, H. and Placia, P. Jr.; Colorado Springs, Colo.: Shepard's/McGraw-Hill, 1981. 2 Vol. Loose leaf. An analysis of the operation of relevant governmental agencies and applicable statutory and case law.
- Judge and Jury in Imperial Brazil, 1808-1897: Social Control and Political Stability in the New State. Flory, T.; Austin, Tex.: University of Texas Press, 1981. Pp. 268. Cloth. A historical perspective of the judiciary in 19th century Brazil.
- Legislative History of American Immigration Policy, 1798-1965. Hutchinson, E.P.; Philadelphia, Pa.: University of Pennsylvania Press, 1981. Pp. xiii, 685. Cloth. An examination of early congressional legislation and its development into a regulation system, through post-McCarran-Walter Act legislation. A wide variety of other immigration issues are also discussed.
- Multilingualism in International Law Institutions. Tabory, M.; The Netherlands: Sijthoff & Noordhoff, 1980. Pp. xx, 284. An examination of problems which attend the drafting and interpretation of multilingual documents. The author offers suggestions on how to minimize such problems.

- Multinational Corporation Law: Mexico, Central America, Panama and the Central American Common Market. Wallace, M., ed.; Dobbs Ferry, N.Y.: Oceana Publications, 1981. Loose leaf. Articles and legislation dealing with the regulation of multinational corporations on a country by country basis.
- North America and the Asia Pacific and the Development of the Law of the Sea: Treaties and National Legislation. Nordquist, M.H. and Choon Ho Park; London; New York: Oceana Publications, 1981. Loose leaf. A collection of treaties and domestic legislation on a country by country basis. The countries covered are the U.S., U.S.S.R., Japan, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North), Republic of Korea (South), the People's Republic of China, Taiwan and the Philippines.
- The Politics of International Air Transport. Gidwitz, B.; Lexington, Mass.: Lexington Books, 1980. Pp. xii, 250. An analysis of the structure of international airlines, emphasizing political elements, and also how governments use airlines for non-aviation purposes. An examination of various regulatory processes is also included.
- Restatement of the Law: Foreign Relations Law of the United States (Revised): Tentative Draft No. 2. Philadelphia, Pa.: The American Law Institute, 1981. Pp. 221. Paper. This draft was submitted by the Council to members of the Institute at the fifty-eighth annual meeting in May of 1981.
- Territorial Asylum. Grahl-Madsen, A.; Dobbs Ferry, N.Y.: Oceana Publications, 1980. Pp. xvi, 231. This study is directed at the problem of refugees which has been particularly perplexing in the past few years. The book examines the international law of the right to grant asylum and the law of extradition, and the constitutional and statutory provisions of many industrialized states.
- Treatise on Air—Aeronautical Law. Matte, N.M.; Toronto: Carswell Co.; Montreal: ICAL, McGill University, 1981. Pp. 832. Cloth. A comprehensive analysis of customary international law and various international agreements which deal with passenger and cargo transport.
